Additions:

- Generic doxycycline 100 mg.
- Famciclovir, valacyclovir, generic acyclovir, Avirax
- Epipen, Anakit, Glucagon Emergency kit
- Dalacin vaginal cream, Dalacin T solution
- Differin gel
- Flonase, Nasonex, Nasocort AQ, Symbicort Turbuhaler
- Insulin, syringes, ultra fine needle pen
- Preventive vaccines
- Rosuvastatin (Crestor), rabeprazole (Pariet)
- Gardasil
- Altace HCT
- DDAVP Melt
- Alvesco inhaler
- Novomix

Note:

- Extemporaneous mixtures will be covered providing one of the ingredients is a covered benefit.

Deletions:

- Sustained release formulations where an underlying generic is available (except Tegretol CR, Ritalin SR, Biaxin XL)
- Over-the-counter drugs
- Ciprofloxacin, cefadroxil, cefazolin, cefprozil, cefuroxime
- Axid, Losec, Pantoloc

Maximums:

- Fertility drugs (\$2000/lifetime)
- Zyban (smoking cessation drug) limited to 90 day lifetime maximum upon approval by Health Services.
